The LectroCount LCR 600's large 5.7" QVGA display and alphanumeric keyboard provide a versatile, user-friendly workspace where the LCR 600's new functionality is possible. New functionalities include: self-contained set up and settings (no lap pad or laptop computer is required for configuration), on-screen diagnostics, and a full-featured point-of-sale utility (an optional upgrade). The point-of-sale utility allows users to define complex tax and pricing structures, apply them to deliveries, and print a complete invoice at the delivery site.

Bigger Display, More Possibility

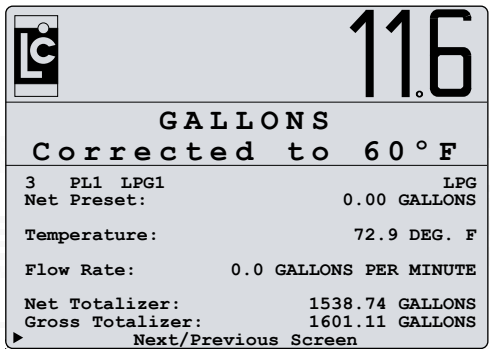

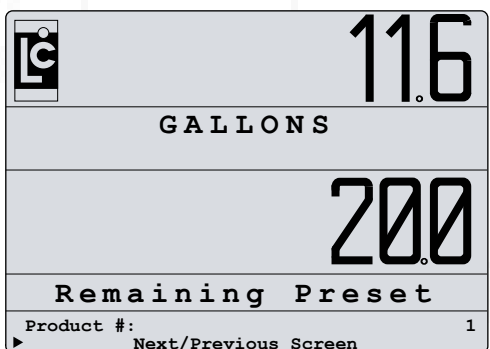

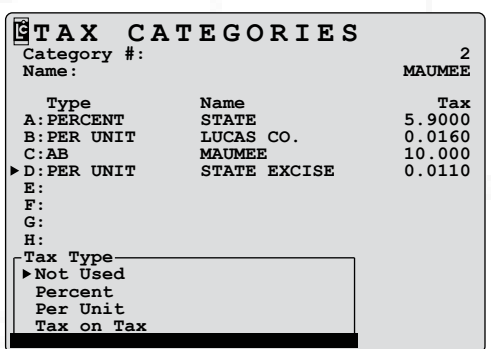

Alphanumeric Keypad

The tactile, alphanumeric keypad is the key component that makes all of the LectroCount LCR 600's new functionality possible. All 14 domed keys pop up and down to give a tactile response and a positive confirmation of keystrokes. Two scrolling keys and two screen navigation keys provide simple maneuvering from screen to screen and through lists. Entering numeric fields, such as presets or ticket messages, is quick and easy using the multitap functionality of the 10 alphanumeric keys.
